Foundational Principles / 建校精神

—Building Character through Buddhism—

The founding spirit of Musashino University lies in our character building education, which is based on the “four great vows” (known as *shiguzeigan* or *hotoke no negai*) that underpin the fundamental principles of Buddhism. According to Dr. Junjiro Takakusu, an internationally renowned Buddhist scholar who is also the founder of Musashino University, the character of a person is built when he or she has lofty ideals, and having a stronger character in turn brings about the emergence of even loftier ideals*. He upheld the Shakyamuni Buddha, the founder of Buddhism, as the ideal of human character, and preached that the true meaning of life lies in our journey toward building our characters in order to achieve that ideal. Hence, the objective of education at Musashino University is to build character, based on the ideal propounded by the “four great vows” and to embody the ideal of these “four great vows” by achieving character improvement.

Founder Dr. Junjiro Takakusu

[1866–1945]

An internationally renowned Buddhist scholar, Dr. Takakusu founded Musashino Women's College—the parent school of Musashino University—based on the ideal of developing human character according to the spirit of Buddhism. He was also a pioneer who understood the need for women's education and took a positive view toward women stepping out into society and taking on an active role. He received the prestigious Order of Culture in 1944.

Building the Future of Musashino University Together for the Next 100 Years

The Musashino University Educational Foundation celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2024. Under the philosophy of the “four great vows,” the fundamental spirit of Buddhism and the foundation for character-building education, the University has produced many graduates over its long history. As the inheritor of their mission, the University hopes to work together with everyone for the next 100 years to create an institution responsive to society’s future needs.

A University Creating Peace and Happiness for the World

Musashino University is looking ahead to the future, with the aim of fulfilling the University’s mission by 2050. Students currently enrolled at the University will be about 50 years old in 2050, an age at which they will be playing a central role in society. Our mission is to prepare individuals who will help create and shape a society of well-being. To achieve that mission, we will move forward with our second medium-term plan on a university-wide basis, aiming for the realization of Student Success, forming young people with well-defined objectives and a clear vision of their future selves and equipping them with the skills and the mindset necessary for bettering society.

Musashino University’s Unique Education Initiatives Sub-major Information Subjects and Field Studies

Musashino University is proceeding steadily with educational reform. In the 2021 academic year, we revamped our series of foundational courses common across all faculties with the launch of Musashino INITIAL. To build the basic capabilities and practical skills needed for forging a path into the future, targeting the year 2050, the courses include: (1) the “AI Utilization Expert” group of sub-major information subjects designed to produce digitally proficient AI experts beyond the humanities and sciences; (2) the “Creating Happiness Program” (CHP), where students learn the philosophy behind the United Nations sustainable development goals (SDGs), bring an awareness of the problems to a self-directed learning approach and acquire practical skills; (3) “Field Studies,” aimed

at providing students with opportunities to choose their own future careers by actually observing and experiencing society and sensing for themselves the usefulness of their specialized areas of study; and (4) “Introduction to Buddhism,” for studying the University’s founding philosophy.

Our second medium-term plan, which will begin in the 2025 academic year, highlights DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion) initiatives to encourage proactive study in our diverse student body.

Steps toward Becoming a Comprehensive University: Establishing New Faculties, Departments and Graduate Schools

Over the past 20 years, Musashino University has set up new faculties, departments and graduate schools, developing into a comprehensive university that now has over 14,000 students in 13 faculties, 21 departments, 13 graduate schools and a Department of Online Learning. With the establishment in 2019 of the Faculty of Data Science, followed in 2021 by the Faculty of Entrepreneurship, the Department of Sustainability Studies in 2023, and the Faculty of Well-being in 2024, we are creating new faculties and departments that anticipate the changing needs of the times and of society, and challenging ourselves to keep moving forward. We will continue establishing new areas of study, in keeping with the traditions of our founding philosophy and in a learning environment conducive to achieving world happiness.

面向下一个百年 共筑武藏野大学的未来

学校法人武藏野大学于 2024 年迎来了百周年校庆。本校秉持“以佛教根本精神‘四弘誓愿’为基础的人格教育”这一建校精神，在漫长的历史中培养出了众多优秀人才。面向下一个 100 年，我们将继承这一使命，与大家共同打造符合未来社会需求的大学。

塑造“创造幸福 感动世界”的大学

武藏野大学将放眼 2050 年的未来，践行大学使命。到 2050 年，现在的在校生正好是 50 岁左右。他们将成为社会的中流砥柱，处于积极贡献社会的时期。本校的使命正是面向这一未来，培养出众多能为创建和发展幸福社会做出贡献的人才。为了实现这一使命，我们正全校范围内推进第二个中期规划，旨在实现“学生的成功”，使每一位学生都能在实现个人愿景和目标的过程中切实感受到自身的成长，并掌握能为社会做出贡献的技能和思维方式。

武藏野大学的原创教育

“辅修信息系列科目”和“实地研究”

我校的教育改革也在切实推进，2021 年度，更新了全校的通识基础课程，并启动了“武藏野 INITIAL”。本课程旨在培养能够开创 2050 年未来所必须拥有的基础能力和实践能力的 (1) 辅修信息系

列科目“AI 应用专家”（培育众多超越文理界限的“AI×专业”数字化人才）；(2) CHP (Creating Happiness Program / 创造幸福项目) 系列科目（学习 SDGs 理念，培养带着问题意识主动学习的姿态和实践能力）；(3) “实地研究”等系列科目（观察并体验现实社会，感受自己所学专业的实用性，并为未来的职业选择做铺垫）；(4) 建校科目“佛学(思考人生哲学)”等科目群。

此外，第二个中期规划将于 2025 年度开始，通过推行 DEI（多样性、公平性和包容性），鼓励多元化的学生开展自主学习。

开设新的学院、学科及研究生院与综合大学化的历程

在过去的 20 多年里，武藏野大学积极推进了学院、学科、研究生院的开设工作。目前，我校已发展成一所拥有 13 个院系、21 个学科、13 个研究生院专业课程和函授教育学院的综合性大学，学生人数达到 14,000 多名。2019 年设立数据科学学院，2021 年设立创业学院，2023 年设立可持续发展学科，2024 年设立幸福共生学院等，始终致力于设立符合时代和社会需求的创新性学院和学科。今后，我们仍将继续致力于在新的领域打造学习平台，在秉承建校精神这一传统的基础上，致力于将我校建设成一个能够追求世界幸福形态的新型高等教育机构。

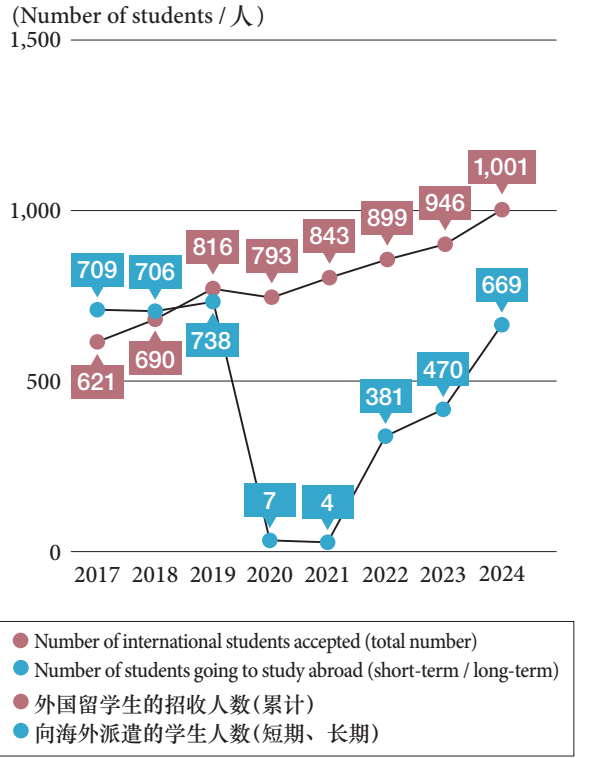

This program allows students with a recommendation from the University to, in principle, study for one year at a partner university/institution overseas. Credits received overseas as well as the study-abroad duration (within a year) can be credited towards their degree at Musashino University, thereby allowing them to graduate in four years.

Scholarship Abroad Program

With the approval of the University, this program allows our students to study for one year or two semesters at the foreign university of their choice. Once they meet program requirements, students may plan their study period or choice of foreign university as they wish. Credits received overseas as well as the study-abroad duration can be credited towards their degree at Musashino University, thereby allowing them to graduate in four years.

Short-term Language Courses

This program offers short-term study at partner universities, junior colleges or language schools overseas. Students spend approximately 2 to 5 weeks during summer or spring vacations living locally and learning a foreign language. The aims of the program are to help students improve their foreign language skills and acquire independent study skills; broaden their outlook through the development of an understanding of other cultures, made possible by cross-cultural experiences; and to foster an appreciation of the diverse customs of other countries.

Open to all students regardless of their language proficiency, this program allows all to potentially experience the appealing prospect of living in a different culture.

We recommend this program to students who do not wish to pause their university studies, since they can study abroad during school holidays.

International Lectures

The International Lectures Series is a special program in which experts from overseas partner universities are invited to conduct undergraduate classes on specialized topics. We anticipate that taking advantage of the opportunities presented by this program will make the global community more familiar to our students, and will help students to proactively develop their own area of specialty, discover global issues, and cultivate the ability to address these issues.

MJSP (Musashino Japanese Studies Program)

The Musashino Japanese Studies Program (MJSP) offers a Japanese language and culture program targeting students at partner universities. In addition to studying the Japanese language according to their proficiency level, students learn more about Japan through participation in traditional cultural activities and exchanges with Japanese students. Begun in 2015, this program attracts many participants from partner universities every year. In addition to MJSP, a new special program was started in the 2025 academic year, where MU students, acting as facilitators, participate in group work and fieldwork with foreign students and all learn together.

国际交流与海外留学

武藏野大学致力于培养拥有广阔视野的国际性人才，分别与 34 个国家和地区的多所大学签署了友好合作协议，开展多领域的学术交流与學生交流。在制定在校生涯海外留学和语言学习辅导制度的同时，也积极地招收外国留学生。

海外留学制度

交换留学

学生可通过大学推荐，原则上到本校的海外协议交流院校留学 1 年的制度。本校承认学生在留学期间取得的学分，留学时间（1 年以内）也计入本校的在籍学习年限，因此可以在 4 年内按期毕业。

SAP 留学制度

经本校批准，学生可在自己选择的大学进行一年或半学期期间海外留学。只要满足一定的条件，即可自由规划留学的大学及留学时期。此外，本校承认学生在留学期间取得的学分，留学时间也计入本校的在籍学习年限，因此可以在 4 年内按期毕业。

短期外语研修

短期语言研修是指在与本校有合作协议的海外大学、短期大学、语言学校等机构进行的短期海外留学项目。该项目的目的是“提高语言能力，获得自主学习能力”、“通过跨文化体验拓宽视野”和“加深对不同文化区域的理解”。学生将利用暑假或春假在当地留学约两至五周，进行外语学习的研修。

该项目的魅力不仅在于语言学习本身，还在于独特的跨文化体验。该项目没有语言能力等要求，任何学生都可以参加。

由于是利用暑假或春假，因此推荐给希望不休学就能出国学习语言的学生。

国际讲座 (International Lectures)

国际讲座项目邀请国外合作院校的专家来我校授课，旨在为学生提供学习国外大学本科专业课程的机会。希望学生们能借此机会，进一步接触国际社会，主观能动地钻研自己的专业，发现世界性课题，并培养解决课题的能力。

MJSP (武藏野大学日本研修)

武藏野大学日本研修 / Musashino Japanese Studies Program (MJSP) 为合作院校的学生举办日语和日本文化研修。参加者除了学习不同水平的实用性日语之外，还将通过日本传统文化体验、与本校学生开展交流会等方式，加深对日本的理解。从 2015 年开始，每年都有大量来自海外合作院校和交流院校的学生参加。2025 年度，除原有的日语学习项目外，本校还将推出一项全新尝试：实施由本校学生担任辅导员，通过小组讨论与实地考察等形式，共同参与学习的特别项目。



Kasai International Dormitory

Kasai International Dormitory was founded on April 2015 as a space where we put into practice the development of global graduates. The five-floor building has 86 rooms, as well as a community lounge on the first floor. International students from around the world, bringing diverse values and a rich global diversity, live and study here together with Japanese resident assistants (RA), contributing to the promotion of mutual understanding and the formation of a wide range of interpersonal relations.

Resonating Nursery Education

Children learn to utilize their capacities and potential to the full and are encouraged to develop self-actualization to discover what they like with perseverance.

Vigorous Play, Zest for Life

Children learn through play. Being absorbed in play helps them discover wonders and develop curiosity and the spirit of exploration. Experiencing the fun of play and feelings of pleasure and accomplishment at doing things with others helps them develop self-esteem, which is the source of zest for life.

Feeling secure surrounded by teachers and peers, children are free to play to their hearts' content and develop a zest for life.

Developing Rich Sensibilities by Experiencing What Is Real

A variety of exciting programs operated in collaboration with Musashino University and specialist institutions provide children with rich experiences. A new program beginning this academic year will introduce children to play through exercise, where they learn to enjoy themselves through physical activity. Other programs include science, play in English, ICT (information and communications technology), growing and harvesting crops, and food education. The "Forest of Books" library provides storytelling and exposure to books. The wealth of experiences offered is designed to develop children's rich sensibilities.

To support child-rearing, this childhood education center provides nursery services on an as-needed basis and stages events for preschoolers. Through the opening of the nursery's playground to the public, provision of advice on child-rearing and other activities, this nursery encourages interaction with the community.

The Spirit of Buddhism

Buddhist teachings are communicated at morning prayer and in daily life. Contact with animals and nature and spending time with their peers helps children develop with a kind heart and respect for life and who can express gratitude for blessings in this world.

The Ariake Center for Early Childhood Education and Care, which is both a kindergarten and a nursery, is a certified childhood education center which also supports those rearing children in the local community. Founded in 2020, Ariake's philosophy is “resonating nursery education” focusing on the five elements of “little friends,” “discovery and wonder,” “physical and emotional health,” “the unknown world” and “life” to realize this.

At Ariake, we emphasize self-actualization so that children may be powered by an engine that enables them to soar freely rather than simply gliding through life. Our aim is to provide nursery education drawing out each child's potential, to enable them to express their personalities and strengths to the fullest.

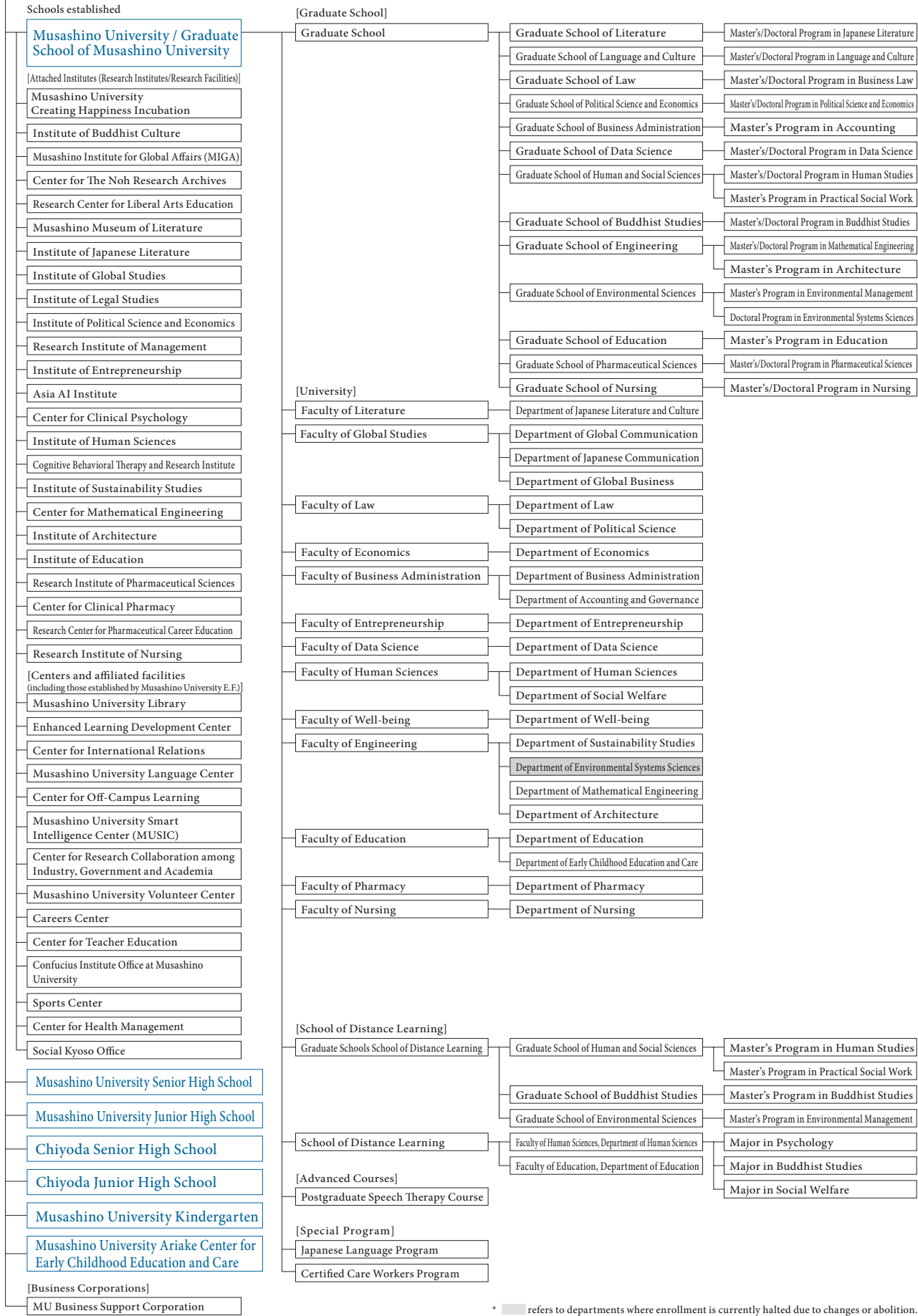

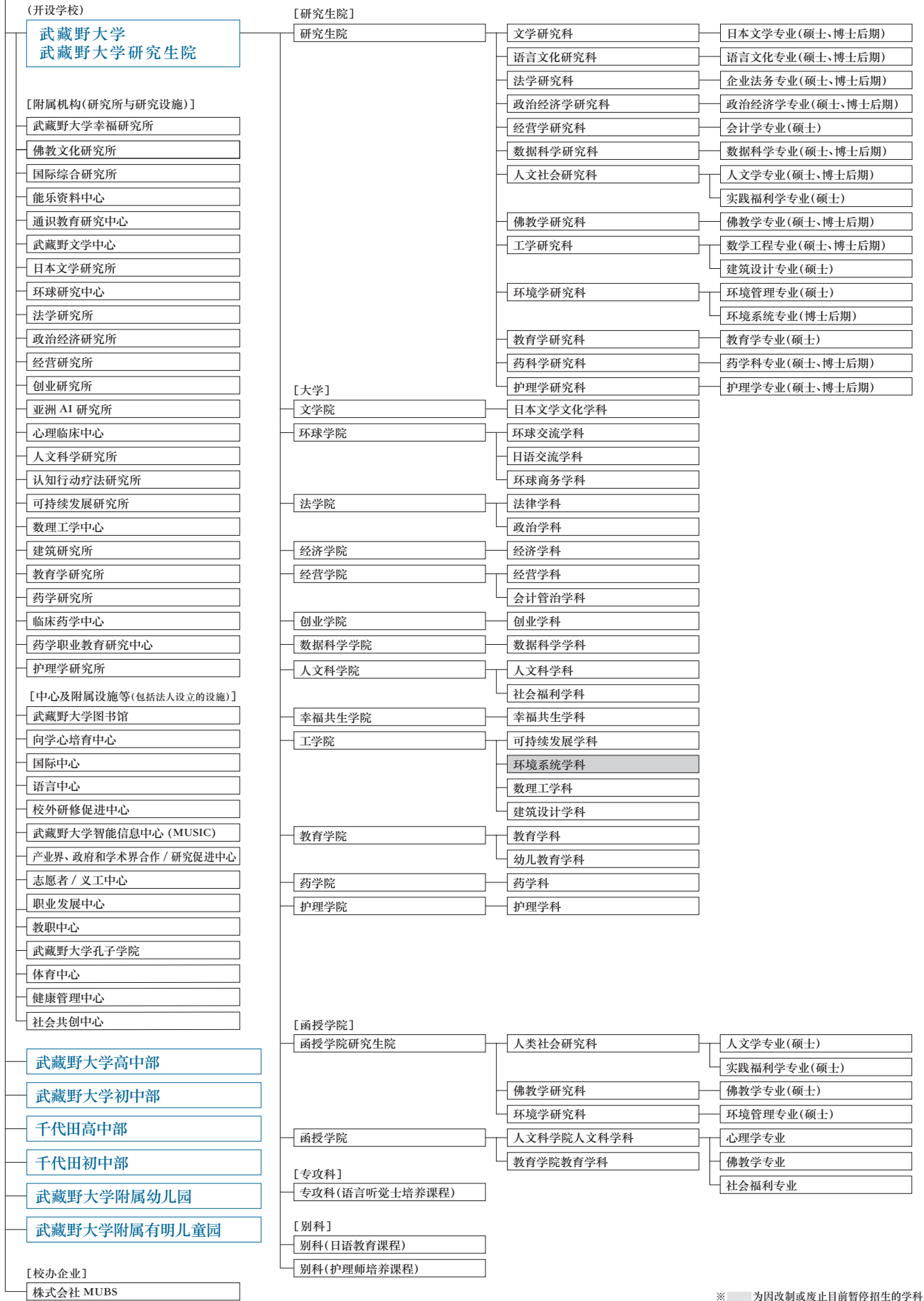

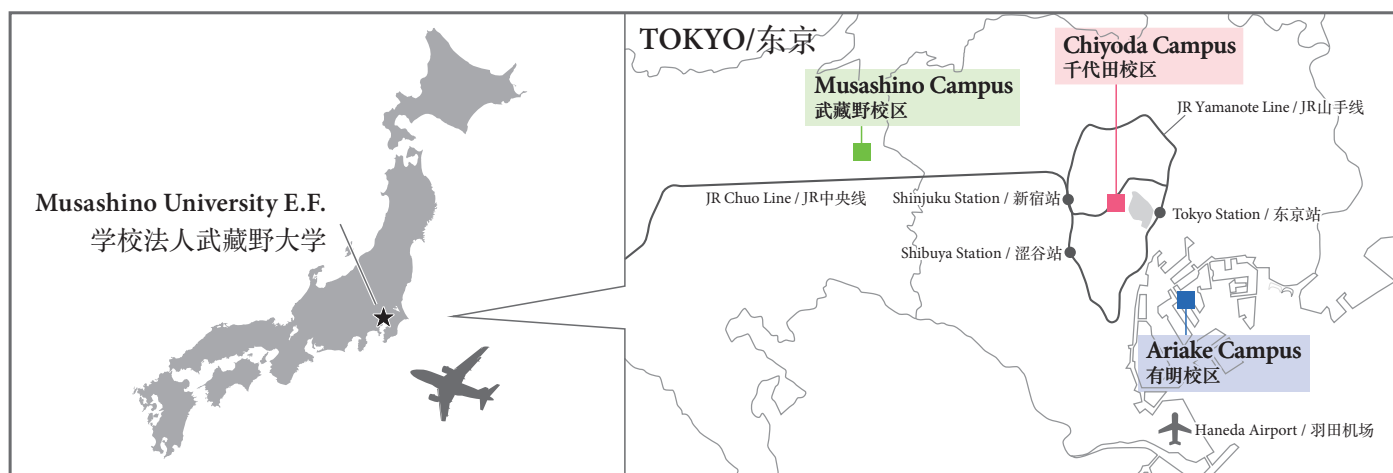
